SYNOPSIS

Rémy and Sandra are unable to conceive a child as they suffer from the "Past Love Syndrome". In order to be cured, they only have one solution: they have to sleep once again with each and every one of their past lovers.

DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

The (Ex)perience of Love is a farcical tale that questions the intricate interlocking of love, sex, and family. In our previous creations, we explored various topics related to couples: first there was jealousy in *Domestic Tale*, then love quarrels in *Lucha Libre*. In *With Thelma*, we disturbed the functioning of a couple's daily routine by dropping a three-year-old child into their lives, and in our feature film *Madly in Life*, it was a parent's dementia that put a couple to the test. With this project, we sought to explore sexuality "outside" the couple. Whether through fantasies or openly voiced, all couples grapple with outside aspirations, and managing one's desire and attraction is a vast topic in any love arrangement.

We therefore placed Rémy and Sandra in a situation where they have to schedule an entire series of infidelities throwing them back to their past love lives. We thus took two pillars of heteronormativity, exclusivity and reproduction, and played them against one another. If Rémy and Sandra want a child together, they will have to first go see elsewhere. And once they have, in the end, reached a point where their relationship is in shambles, they regroup towards the essential, what they've lost and now want to rekindle more than anything: the pleasure they have living together, to be in the specific sphere that is their relationship, in short, their love.



Just as in *Hibernatus*, we wanted to start off with an absurd scientific premise to trigger a reflection on sexuality and reproduction, using comedy as our background. We wanted to follow Rémy and Sandra through this incongruous adventure, discovering through a series of former partners a number of variations on the same theme - as the exes have also developed their own system within the couple they're currently involved in – and question the way in which we collectively approach the project of having a child, often transforming our offspring into trophies, a tool for social recognition, or a feature to add to one's picture of the perfect life. We hope and have the ambition to make the public laugh when faced with the illusions and taboos that structure the way we collectively function, and to explore with humor the diktats that pressure us into

a monocultural single family pattern that inhibits our creativity, in order to be able to reinvent how we live together.

As in our previous projects, we were intent on developing a specific formal expression supporting the story and enhancing comedy through visual stylization. In the film's structure, we created a space with a rather particular narrative status that is slightly off with respect to the rest of the film's naturalism. There, the scenes taking place in the Room of Exes and the metaphorical sexual scenes represent the characters' mental space, the unexplored inner territories, that Sandra and Rémy are going to open up and discover. In these scenes, sexuality is always depicted in a symbolic manner, playing hide-and-seek and dissimulation games with the settings,

with movement. Nudity is approached in a humble and playful way: the body in its simplest state, a body whose purpose is to move, invent, laugh.

We organized the casting process rather gradually. We like working with a mix of actors and actresses with whom we have built a professional relationship over the years and others that we're discovering. This is reflected in our main characters, embodied by Lucie Debay, with whom we worked for our first feature film *Madly in Life*, and Lazare Gousseau, with whom we've collaborated for the first time, convinced by his humanism, his sensitivity and his natural flair for comedy. Lazare enables us to experience, in a tender and subtle way, the masculine insecurities of our world.



ABOUT THE DIRECTORS

Ann Sirot and Raphaël Balboni are a pair of fiction author-directors. They have directed eight short films and two features films together. Through these projects, they have developed an unconventional and offbeat world, a hybrid and atypical form of cinema epitomized by surreal and joyful oneirism. With their short films Lucha Libre and With Thelma, they established a work method based on free and spontaneous acting, a lively rhythm through jump cut editing and an organic narrative construction where happy accidents find their way into the storyline.

Their first feature film, *Madly in Life*, is a bittersweet comedy in which we follow a couple grappling with a parent suffering from an Alzheimer-like disease. The film received seven Magritte awards as well as numerous other awards in various festivals.

Their second feature film, *The (Ex)perience of Love*, is a romantic comedy through which the authors question the way we regard love, desire, experience, and the wish to have a child.
